DEPOSIT - the money you put into your bank account.


INTEREST - this is money the bank pays to you for their use of the money you deposit. Save more, you'll earn more!

Crispy Butterfly Treats!



INGREDIENTS:

- 3 tablespoons of butter or margarine
- 1 10-ounce pkg. of marshmallows (about 40)
- 6 cups rice breakfast cereal (like Rice Krispies)
- · A small can of pre-made frosting
- · Assorted candies to decorate butterflies

Use a butterfly-shaped cookie cutter (or just use clean hands to shape your butterflies!)

STOVE-TOP DIRECTIONS (WITH PARENTS!):

- In large saucepan, melt butter over low heat.
 Add marshmallows and stir until completely melted. Remove from heat.
- 2. Add rice cereal. Stir until well coated.
- 3. Using buttered spatula or wax paper evenly press mixture into 15 x 10 x 1-inch pan coated with cooking spray. Cool slightly. Using cookie cutters coated with cooking spray cut into butterfly shapes. Decorate with frosting and/or candies. Best if served the same day.

MICROWAVE DIRECTIONS (WITH PARENTS!):

In microwave-safe bowl heat butter and marshmallows on HIGH for 3 minutes, stirring after 2 minutes. Stir until smooth. Follow steps 2 and 3 above. (Microwave cooking times may vary.)

For best results, remember to use fresh marshmallows!
